


Why National Women's Tech Week?



National Women's Tech Week was created to empower Nigerian women and girls in STEM and digital innovation.

Women remain underrepresented in technology fields in Nigeria. Many face barriers such as limited access to skills training, lack of role models, low visibility, and fewer opportunities for leadership in tech.





Key reasons for the initiative: 🔑

- **Closing the gender gap in STEM**

Less than one-third of Nigeria's STEM workforce is female. Women's Tech Week aims to change that by inspiring and preparing more women to lead and excel.

- **Fostering inclusion in the digital economy**

As the world shifts to digital, no one should be left behind. The program equips women and girls with the skills and networks they need to compete and thrive.

- **Driving innovation and national development**

Research shows diverse teams build better solutions. Empowering more women in STEM fuels innovation and strengthens Nigeria's technological progress.

- **Creating a national platform for collaboration**

The Week brings together government agencies, schools, private sector, and women leaders to discuss solutions and take action.




